CPR and Defibrillator Training Event at St T's: Sunday 27th October 12 to 2pm

Please keep this date in your diary. Straight on after the All Age service on Sunday 27th October, volunteers from St John Scotland and the City Defibrillator project will be with us to provide information and training on CPR and the defibrillator that we have installed at the front door of the church. The training is suitable for both adults and children and will also be advertised around Corstorphine and we expect to welcome visitors who can drop in at any point between 12 and 2pm.

Launched in 2016 the St John and the City defibrillator project has placed more than 120 public access defibrillators across Edinburgh and the surrounding area with some great news stories, including at Edinburgh Castle, one on each of the city's trams and now one at St T's front door; more information from Jeremy Southam.
